THE KEYNOTE ADDRESSES

Our theme this year is "Choice Theory: The Gateway to Personal Wellbeing". Our first Keynote Speaker, Dr Terry Lynch has been a critic of the medical model of "mental illness" for many years. and in his new book "Depression Delusion Volume One: The Myth of the Brain Chemical Imbalance" he brings together the irrefutable evidence of the delusional nature of the "chemical imbalance" theory of depression, and how it can never have the answer to human wellbeing. Dr Lynch is a medical doctor, and a practicing, accredited psychotherapist. We are delighted to welcome him and his fascinating insights back to our Conference this year.
