Animal & Agri-Science

The Pre-University programme in Animal & Agri-Science is designed to equip learners with the skills and underlying knowledge required to work in the evolving sector of animal and agri-science related industries. Students will receive a solid foundation in Biology and basic Agri-Science principles and practices. The course also includes an opportunity to provide direct care to animals through course study as well as through a work setting. Career opportunities in this area include: Boarding Kennels or Shelter Veterinary Nurse, Veterinary Assistant, Zoo Keeper and Agriculture Science.
