**TU Dublin - City Campus is delivering a new educational programme which provides a stepping stone for young people who are interested in apprenticeships.**

### **Who is the Access to Apprenticeship Programme for?**

The course is aimed at young men and women aged between 16 and 24 living in Dublin who experience social and economic barriers to work and/or education.

### **When?**

The next 12 week course begins in April 2019 and another one will run in September 2019.

### **Where?**

TU Dublin - City Campus Bolton Street and work placement locations.

### **How many weeks?**

Full-time for 12 weeks, including the last two weeks on work placement.

### **What does the course cover?**

Topics covered will include:

- Sampling a range of apprenticeships in; Construction, Engineering, Electrical and Motor & Aviation Industries
- New apprenticeships
- Preparing your CV and Interview Skills
- Two weeks work placement
- Health & Safety and Safe Pass Certificates

### **Do I need to have any qualifications?**

Apprentices must be at least 16 years of age and have a minimum of grade D in any five subjects in the Junior Certificate or equivalent. Employers may require additional minimum qualifications.

### **Is there a cost?**

The course is free.

- Preparing you for starting an apprenticeship
- Continuous Professional Development (CPD) Certificate
