Cutting-edge programme to develop and strengthen Social Enterprise Design Thinking - a new approach to starting or growing a social enterprise

The Rise programme is radically different from the majority of programmes available for Social Enterprise development.

Based on a three-year pan-European research programme (on why social enterprises have failed to achieve sustainability) this programme incorporates two cutting- edge entrepreneurial processes – design thinking and action coaching.

Free to a limited number of applicants, training and mentoring with an estimated commercial value of €15,000 is now available to selected social entrepreneurs and social enterprises with ambitious plans for growth and impact.

For the Impact-driven Social Entrepreneur, weary of traditional business development approaches, this course teaches disruptive thinking, rapid prototyping and self-funded sustainable approaches.

Re-Design Your Thinking - take action - apply to Rise!

This programme will equip participants to:

• Prepare a brief outlining the desired impact, value-add and benefit they seek to achieve through the process, setting aside previously held assumptions, beliefs and preferences in framing the social problem and concerns being addressed.

 Design a research methodology and process, incorporating extensive end-user "empathy-based" interviews, journey-mapping and an end-user persona analysis.

• Use a range of "disruptive" brainstorming techniques to devise innovative approaches to problem statements.

• Create and test multiple prototypes to replace/ generate new income streams.

• Create an Impact-Based, Value-Added business canvas for the successful prototypes. Leadership, human-resource and sales/ fundraising issues are explored and analysed.

• Develop a business plan, human resource plan, board/ governance support programme and financing programme.
