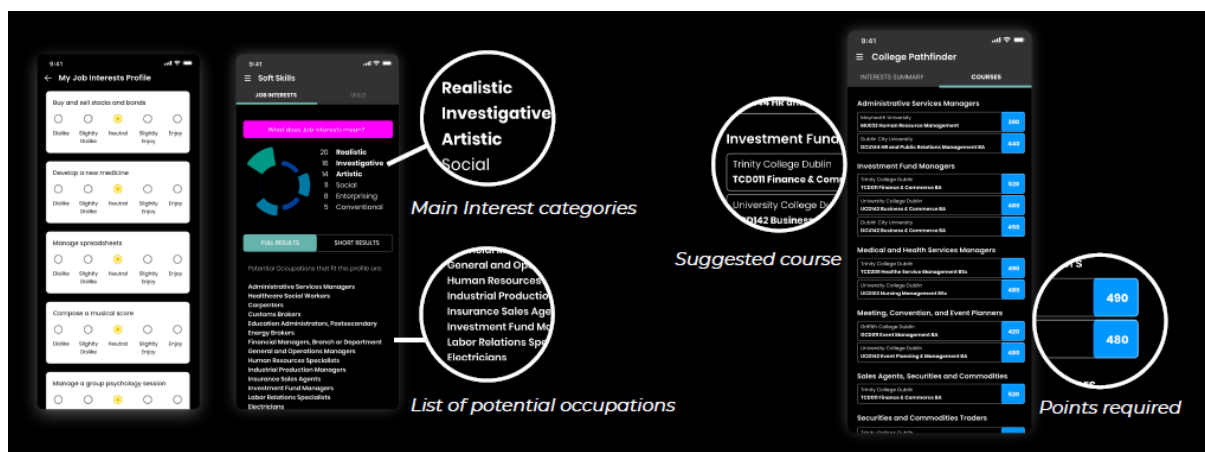

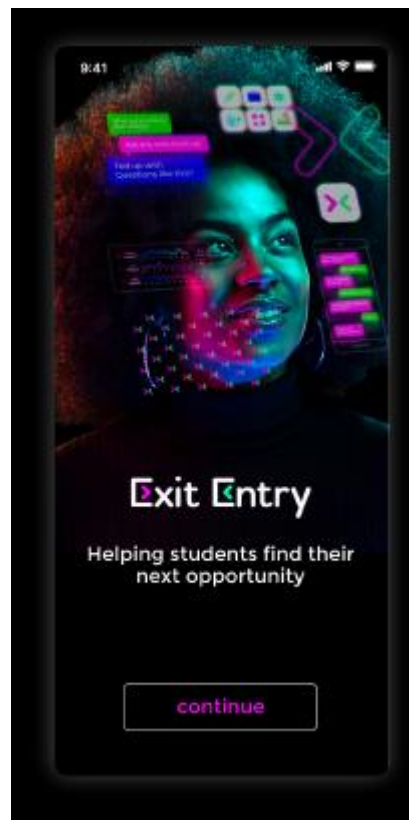


**Figure 1: Screenshot of the app in action, profiling the student's skills and suitable courses.**
