



Camp Overview

Our virtual *Career Guidance Camps* provide 4th, 5th and 6th year students with the skills required to develop an effective career plan. The focus of our camps is not just on skills and knowledge development, but it is also about the application of these skills. Students will leave our camps with better research skills, better decision-making skills and better awareness of learning opportunities and paths available to them as they transition out of secondary school.

Learning & Teaching

Participants will learn, discover and achieve. Our sessions are prepared, designed and delivered with the learner in mind, and foster interaction and engagement in a supportive environment. We use video case studies, stories and carefully designed worksheets to enable participants to become active learners. We embrace ICT tools such as Mentimeter, Padlet and Kahoot (we know how much our young people enjoy quizzes). We also show participants how they can broaden their college experience by getting involved in extra and co curricular life at college and by taking on leadership roles.

Our Pathways Career Guidance Camp takes a broader focus on career planning, allowing students to explore courses and career possibilities across a range of pathways: PLC's, apprenticeships and applications through the CAO.

We break down college terminology, investigate the National Framework of Qualifications (NFQ) looking at how all learning achievements may be measured and related to each other. We explore SUSI grants, the Disability Access Route to Education (DARE), the Higher Education Access Route (HEAR) and scholarships, how they can support students and how to apply. We delve into the CAO application process looking at requirements, points, offers, acceptances and deferrals. Participants also have the opportunity to learn about the UCAS and EU college application process.

Our STEM Career Guidance Camp presents a thematic focus on opportunities in the area of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. Participants learn about labour market trends in STEM and learn about industry facts. We invite guest speakers to discuss opportunities in the world of
