PART-TIME DAY COURSES

Back to Education Initiative (BTEI)

The BTEI is a part-time further education programme designed to meet the education and training needs of young people (over 16 years) and adults.

In most circumstances BTEI is free to qualifying participants.

Participation on this programme can provide opportunities to continue your learning, develop new skills, pursue new employment opportunities, obtain National Certification.

Some examples of BTEI Programmes and Modules which may be undertaken include employment skills, computer skills, general office skills, personal and interpersonal development, work practices, etc.

ERASMUS+ is an EU Programme for education. Students participating in the project are given the opportunity to gain European work placement. To date the College has travelled to Vienna and Barcelona. The project will cover students travel and expenses for the duration of their placement. This once in a lifetime opportunity allows students from North Connaught College to develop their skills and knowledge, and experience life and work in another culture!



NEW INTERNATIONAL BEAUTY QUALIFICATIONS

We now offer new Certificates and Diploma providing students with training in the latest technologies currently available, therefore offering the best possible start to a career in the Beauty industry.

🎓 **Certificate in Microdermabrasion** (ITEC Qualification). This is an ITEC Certificate. This course will equip learners with the theory and practical skills needed for safe and effective reduction of fine lines, wrinkles and milia. Using the highest quality Corundum crystals which are sprayed at variable pressure on the skin leaving a healthy glow and youthful appearance. This highly popular treatment is an excellent qualification to add to your skillset!

🎓 **Diploma in Laser and IPL** (ITEC Qualification). This is an ITEC Diploma. This course gives you the theory and practical skills needed for safe and effective hair reduction and skin rejuvenation treatments, vascular lesions and benign pigmented lesions. We use both Laser and IPL machines. Upon completion of the course learners will have treated all body and face areas for hair removal and skin treatments in a clinical environment.

There is a part-time option for qualified Therapists. You must hold ITEC Beauty Specialist Diploma or equivalent.

NUI Galway and **St. Angela's College** reserve a number of places on their Teacher Education programmes for students who are applying to the CAO using QQI (FE) qualifications. For the past three years NCC has participated on St. Angela's College Access to Post-primary Teaching (APT) Project, and having established good working relationships with them, we would hope to maintain these relationships and continue to encourage and support our students to progress to further education in St. Angela's.

Graduates from three of our Level 6 courses are eligible to apply for advanced entry to Year 2 of certain programmes provided by **Galway-Mayo Institute of Technology**.

Those from Advanced Montessori with ECCE can apply for the Year 2 BA in Early Childhood Education & Care. Those from Advanced Administration can apply for Year 2 in a variety of Bachelor of Business and BSc in Business Information Systems courses. From the Leadership in Community, Social & Youth Work one can apply for Year 2 in the BA Community Development & Youth Work.
