NOW IN A FOURTH YEAR, THESE AWARDS CELEBRATE AND ACKNOWLEDGE OUR ALMOST 30,000-STRONG COMMUNITY OF APPRENTICES, THEIR RESILIENCE, ADAPTABILITY AND CONTRIBUTION.

Nominations to the awards competition are free. They can be made by an employer, training provider, fellow apprentice, anyone who knows an apprentice well and believes that they deserve to be acknowledged with a national Generation Apprenticeship award. Nominations must be submitted using the online nomination form, this is available on the homepage of www.apprenticeship.ie.

Don't miss your chance to showcase and celebrate apprentices in your industry, sector, education and training organisation or region.

Organised by the National Apprenticeship Office, the awards spread the word on how apprenticeship in Ireland is transforming our workplaces and creating education and training opportunities for talented people of all ages, backgrounds and abilities. Every week more and more employers are choosing to recruit apprentices to ensure that their businesses grow and prosper.

Submitting a nomination

From today 01 May the nominations process is open for entries. Nominations are free and the nomination form is available on www.apprenticeship.ie. Nominations must be made using the online nomination form which is

available on the homepage of www.apprenticeship.ie. A copy of the nomination form is provided for information overleaf.

In general, there should only be a single nomination per apprentice. An organisation/individual may however nominate multiple apprentices. Apprentices must be currently completing an apprenticeship at the time of being nominated. An independent panel of judges will adjudicate on the awards after the closing date for nominations has passed, with a national awards ceremony planned for October 2025. Nominated apprentices will be assessed on their contribution in the areas of leadership, teamwork, creativity and problemsolving. Those nominating apprentices should include as many practical, 'real world' examples as possible.

Structure of the awards

The 2025 Apprentice of the Year awards will recognise and celebrate apprentices in all industries and sectors. Shortlisting may be used in line with the assessment criteria ahead of the final judging process and announcement of national award winners in October. We are looking forward to seeing great representation across all regions and apprenticeship occupations.
